^{*}Each district's funding allocation amount consists of an initial \$50,000 deminimus amount with 50 percent of the remaining post-deminimus funds allocated proportionate to the size of the district's population and the other 50 percent allocated based on the district's share of the most recent 3-year average number of part 1 violent crimes. For the 2024 PSN calculations, the most recent years of crime data available covered the period between 2020 and 2022. The populations for each of the judicial districts, including the District of Columbia and U.S. territories, were determined based on the 2023 midyear population estimates published by the U.S. Census Bureau.
