Note: The allocations are based on a formula that provides each State and Territory with a base amount, plus an allocation in proportion to the ratio that its prison population bears to the total prison population of all States and Territories. The prison population includes all inmates under the jurisdiction of the State or Territory for whom the State has legal authority and responsibility. The counts include inmates who may be housed in other States, county or city jails, or other adult correctional facilities. As of December 31, 2001, inmates sentenced to more than 1 year in the District of Columbia were held under the responsibility of the Federal Bureau of Prisons.

¹State prisoner counts are as of December 31, 2010 as reported to the Bureau of Justice Statistics in the National Prisoner Statistics Program (NPS-1B).

²For States with an integrated prison and jail system, prisoner counts include only those inmates with sentences of greater than 1 year.

³Prisoner counts for the territories are based on the most recent data available; the data year of most recent available data varies. Data for American Samoa and Northern Mariana Islands are as of December 31, 2008. Data for Puerto Rico and Virgin Islands are as of December 31, 2009. Data for Guam are as of December 31, 2011
