

## FY 2017 Smart Prosecution Initiative

**Project Description:** Smart Prosecution seeks to encourage exploration of new solutions to public safety concerns, as well as internal operations and organizational structure, while employing research partners to access the sites strategies and solutions. Some creative solutions developed by prosecutors around the country include changing how their organizations prioritize cases, using zone/geographic prosecution, using crime analysis tools to reduce gun violence, preventing crime through environmental design, establishing drug-free and prostitute-free zones, and using crime analysis and cyber-crime strategies to improve public safety and reduce violent crime. Prosecutors are becoming partnership builders who bring the police, the community, and other criminal justice and local agencies together to find ways they can work collaboratively to solve violent crime problems in their jurisdictions.
