- **Presented for GAC Approval: *Promising Practices in Forensic Lab Intelligence***

This CICC-developed resource (included in the GAC meeting folders) provides law enforcement intelligence units with promising practices and recommendations on how to develop or enhance the relationships between forensic labs and intelligence units to further build out agency intelligence efforts. The resource includes both general and lab discipline-specific promising practices, as well as sample products illustrating lab and intelligence unit collaborative efforts. The recommendations contained in this resource are drawn from research, deliberation with law enforcement and lab subject experts, and multiple field interviews and joint forensic lab and intelligence unit site visits.
