

The Rialto Police Department's Body-Worn Video Camera Experiment:

Operation "Candid Camera"



The Problem

- The public's perception of police use of force continues to be a concern.
- "Too many" incidents in which officers resort to use of force.

Officers misinterpreting the contact or aggressive suspects?

• "High number" of citizens' complaints against police officers.

Officers misbehaving or bogus complaints?

Hypothesis

- Wearing body-worn video cameras
 reduce the number of complaints against
 officers compared to the control group?
- Wearing body-worn video cameras
 reduce the number (instances) of use-of force compared to the control group?

Study Results

- 60% reduction in officer use of force incidents following camera deployment.
- Half the number of use of force incidents for shifts with cameras compared to shifts without cameras.
- 88 percent reduction in number of citizen complaints between the year prior to and following camera deployment.
