Cummings Awards Constituent Congressional Badge of Bravery

Cummings (MD-07) will join U.S. Senator Ben Cardin, U.S. Attorney for the U.S. District Court for the District of Maryland Rod Rosenstein, Chief of Police for the Metropolitan Police Department of the District of Columbia (MPD) Cathy Lanier, Commanding Officer of the Navy Yard Captain Monte Ulmer, and other law enforcement officials in awarding Ellicott City resident, Officer Dorian DeSantis, with the State and Local Congressional Badge of Bravery.
