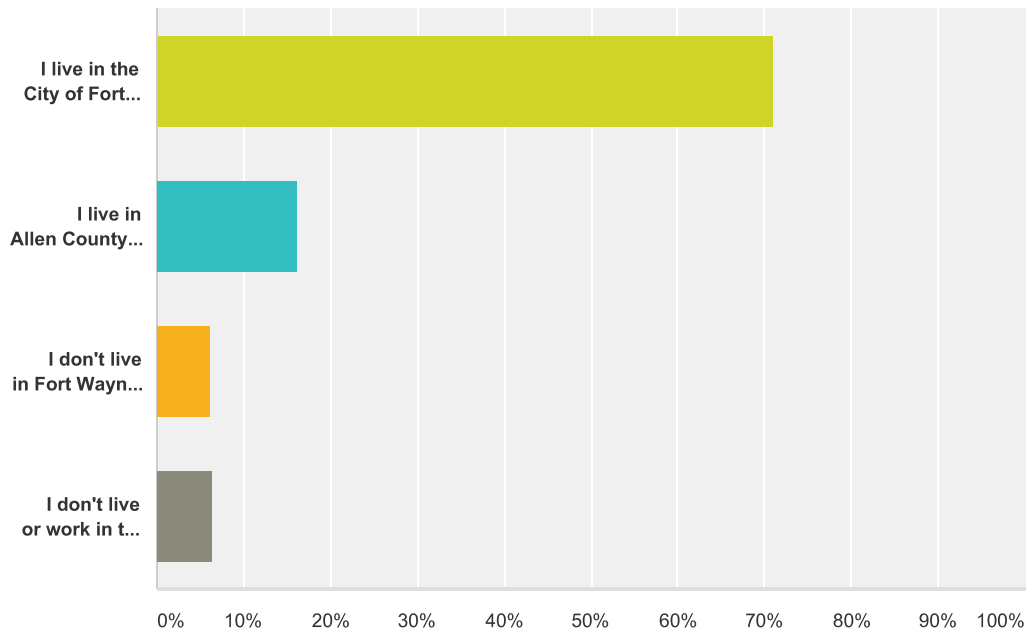

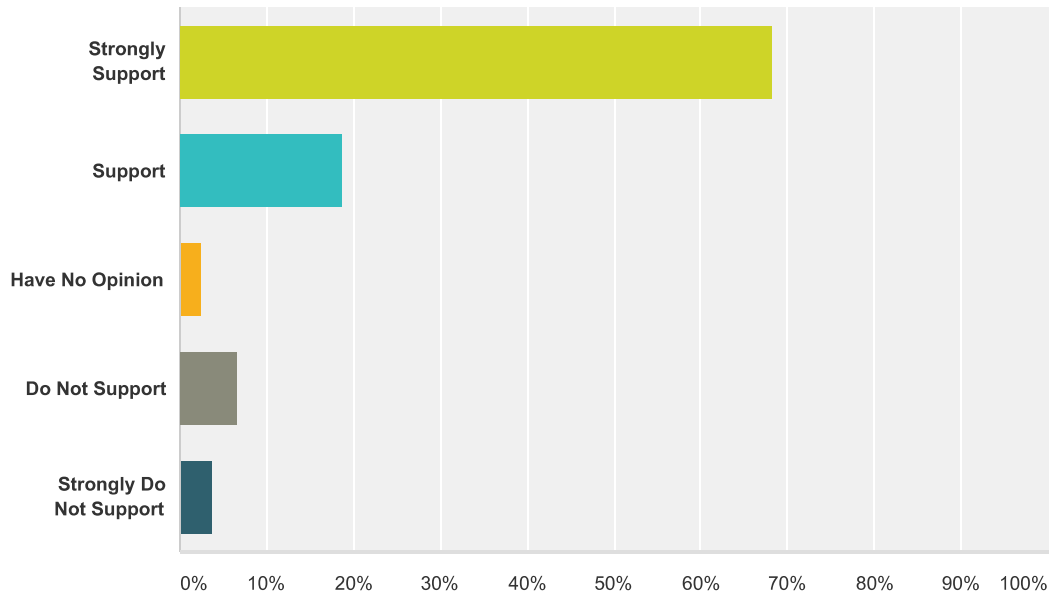

Q2 How much do you support the use of body-worn cameras by Fort Wayne Officers?

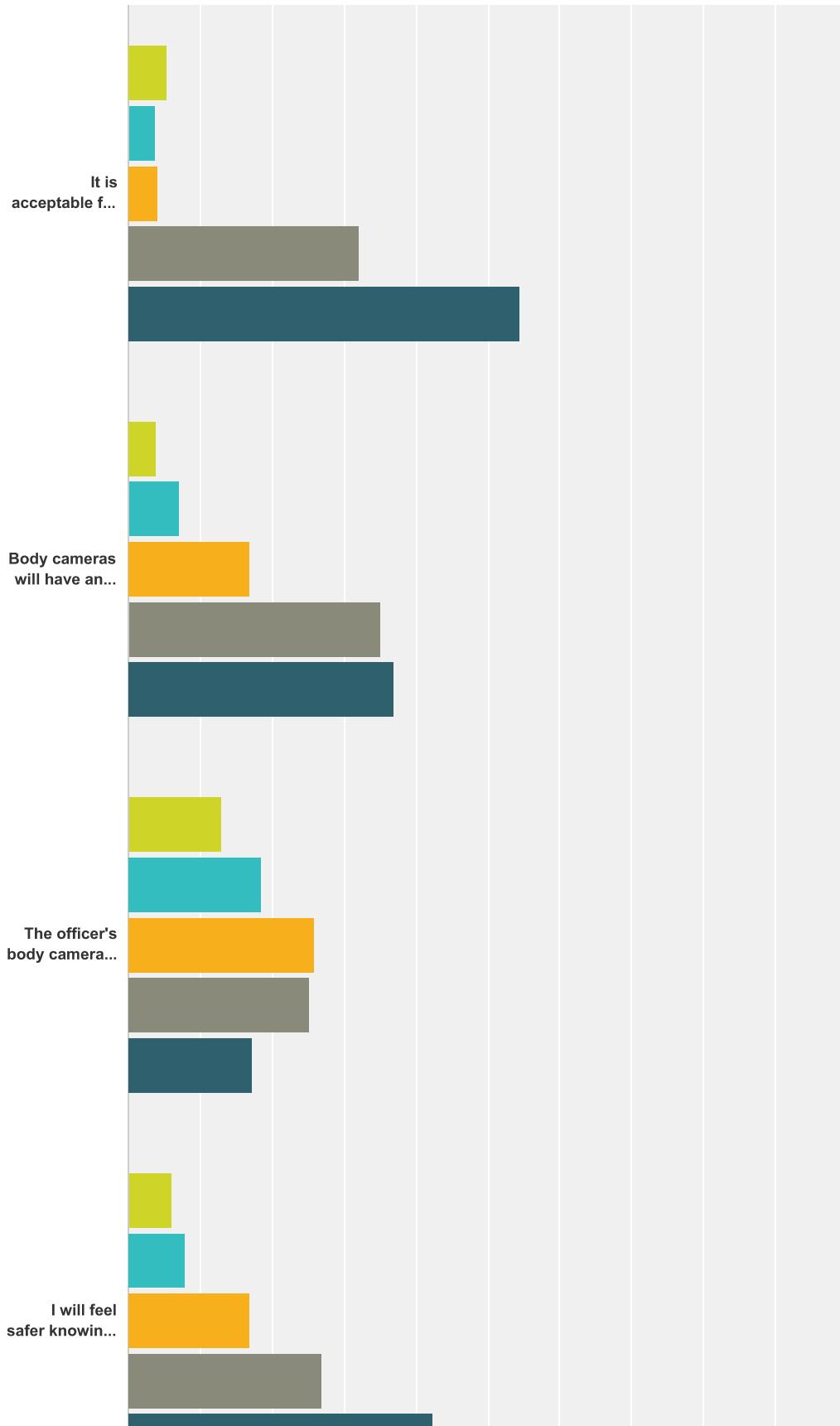

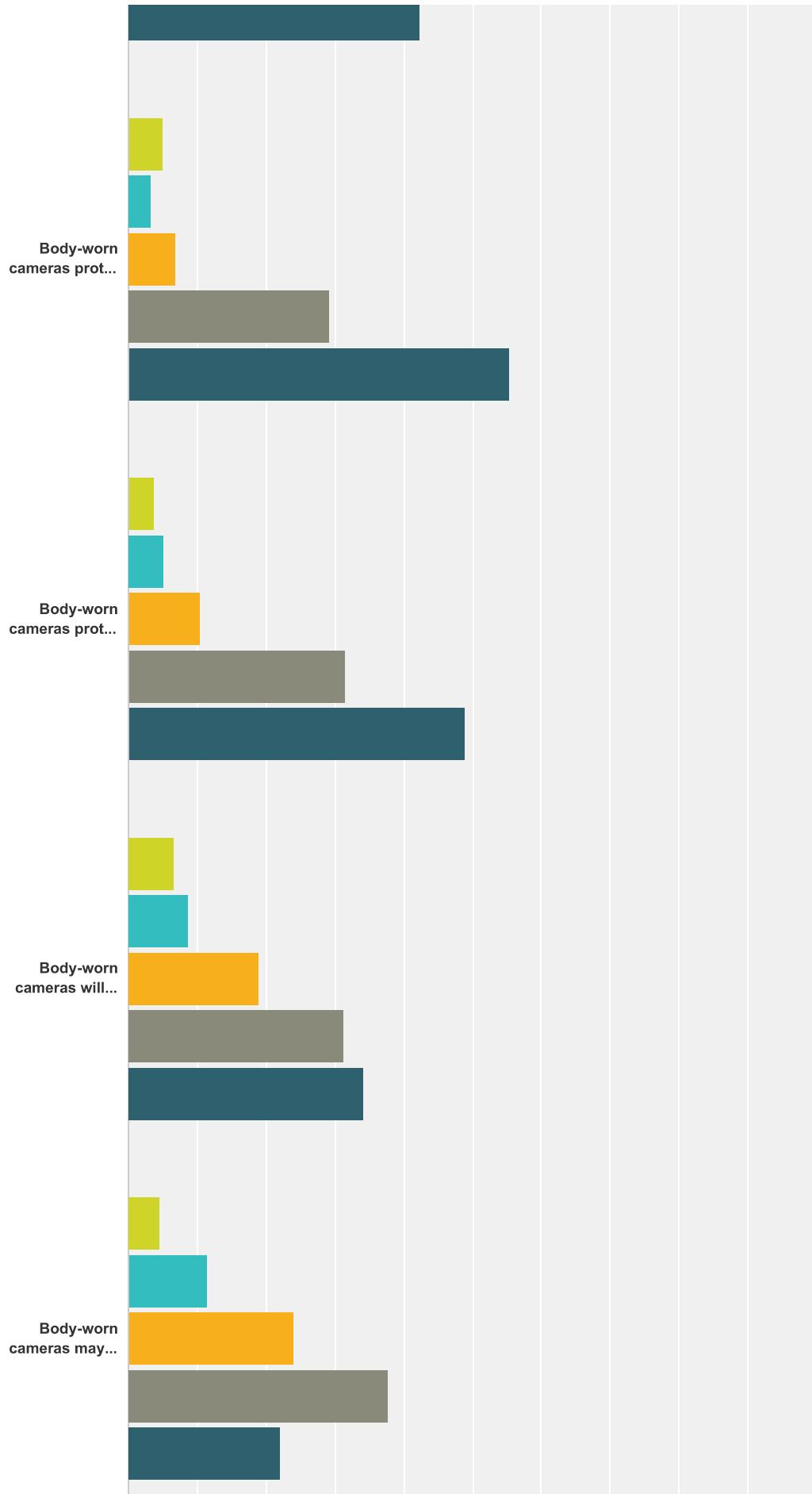

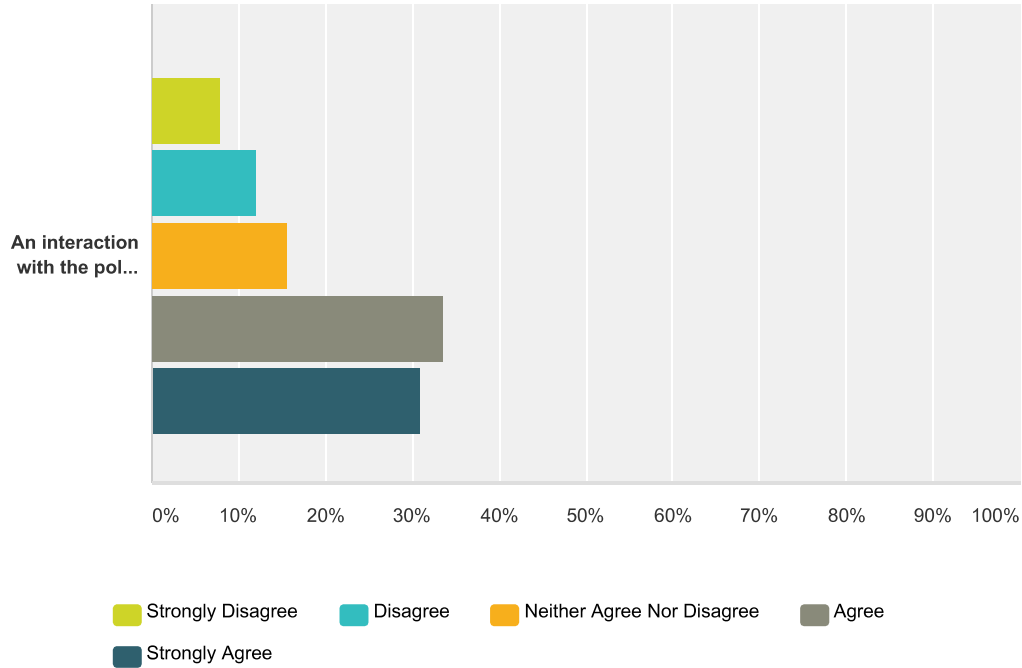

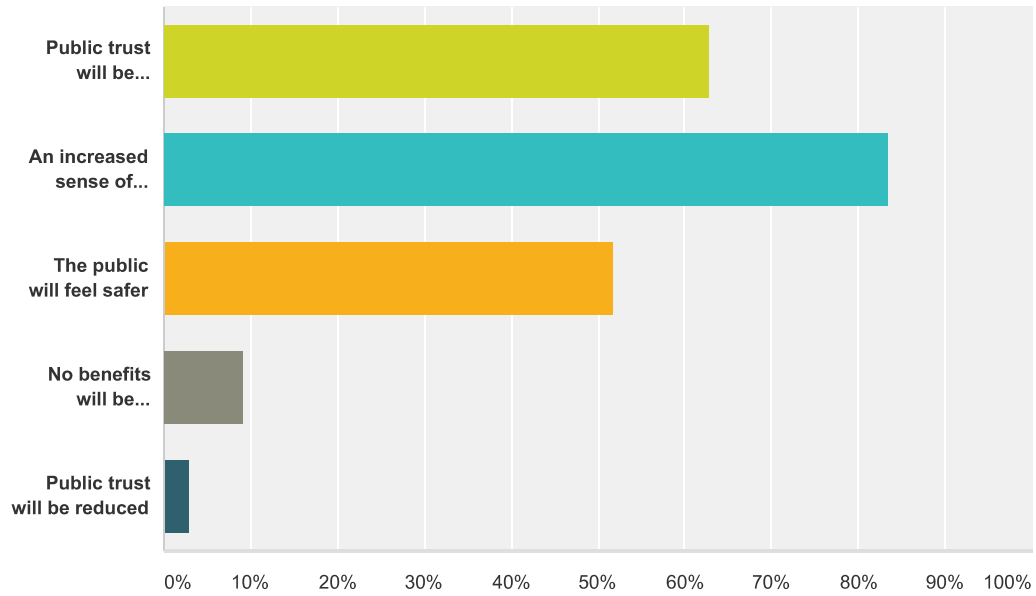

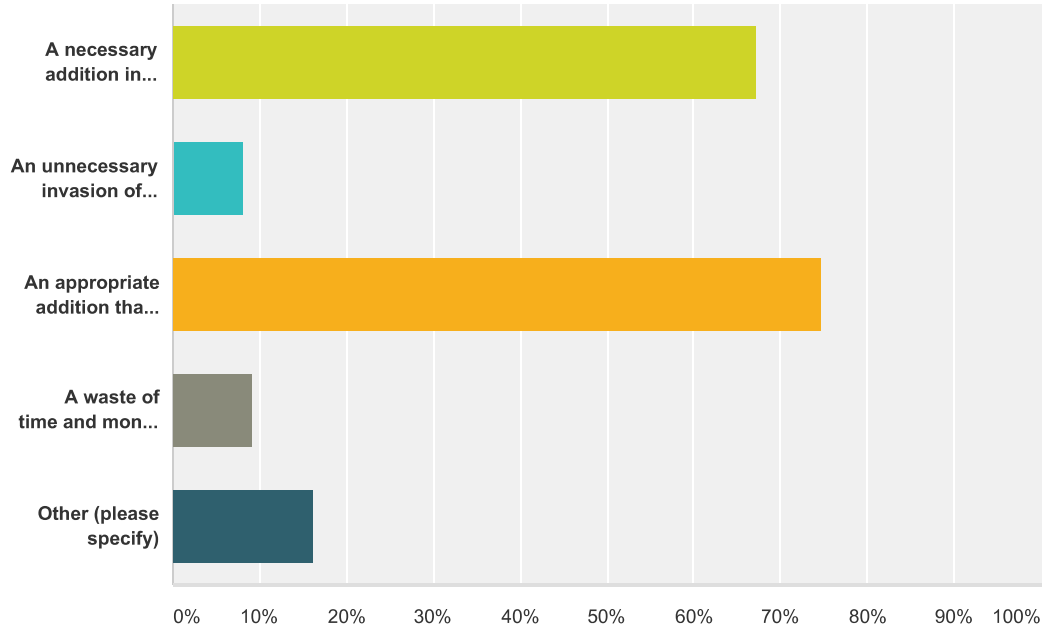

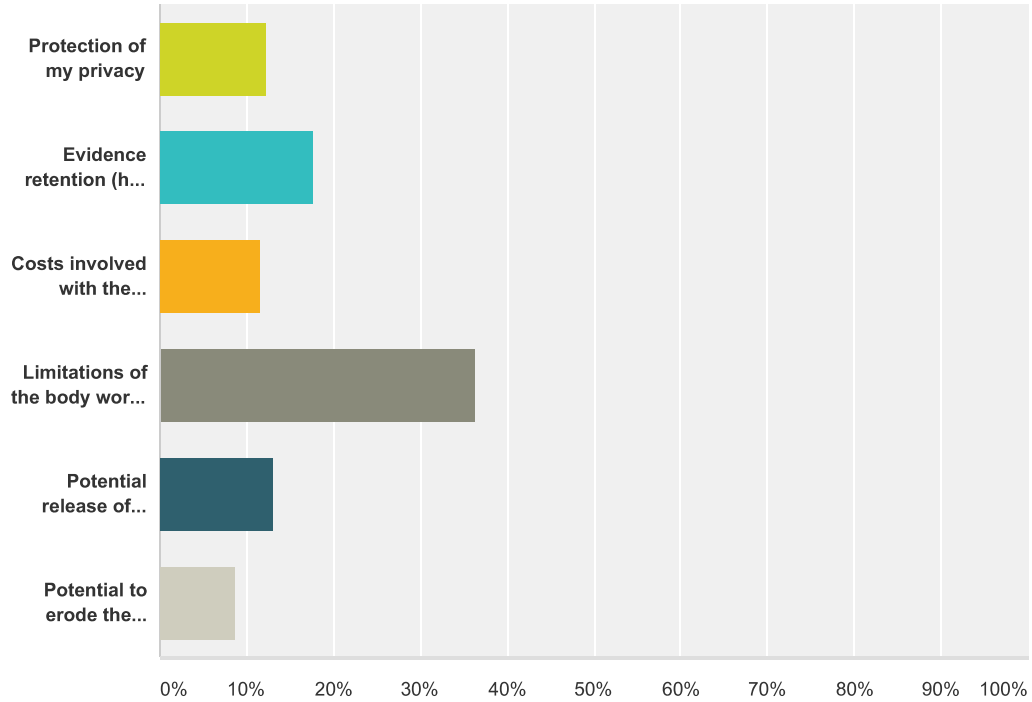
