Project Description: The Sexual Assault Kit Initiative Site-Based Program provides state and local jurisdictions with resources to address the challenge of unsubmitted sexual assault kits in their custody, including support to inventory, test, and track sexual assault kits; create and report performance metrics; access necessary training to increase effectiveness in addressing the complex issues associated with these cases and engage in multidisciplinary policy development, implementation, and coordination; and improve practices related to investigation, prosecution, victim engagement, advocacy, and support in connection with evidence and cases resulting from the testing process. This work supports several of the Administration's priorities including addressing violent crime with a focus on violent and serial offenders and supporting law enforcement, prosecutors, and victims.
