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### The Michael Morton Act

The heart of SB 1611 is Sect. 2 (a) which reads: " . . . as soon as practicable after receiving a timely request from the defendant the state shall produce and permit the inspection and the electronic duplication, copying, and photography by or on behalf of the defendant, of any offense reports, any designated documents, papers, written or recorded statements of the defendant or a witness, including witness statements of law enforcement officers but not including the work product of counsel for the state in the case and their investigators and their notes or report or any designated books, accounts, letters, photographs, or objects or other tangible things not otherwise privileged that constitute or contain evidence material to any matter involved in the action and that are in the possession, custody, or control of the state or any person under contract with the state."

GENERAL ORDER: 506.04 SUBJECT: Digital Recording System

General Order 506.04. Officer-Worn Digital Recording System, is a new order which addresses the emerging technology of officer-worn digital recording devices. These recordings can be useful for the documentation of evidence, preparation of officers reports, and future court testimony. These recordings may also be used to protect officers from false allegations of misconduct as well as provide training material for incident debriefing or performance evaluations. The provisions of this order are effective immediately.

#### 506.04 OFFICER-WORN DIGITAL RECORDING SYSTEM

- A. The guidelines in this order apply to all officer-wom digital recording devices regardless of whether the device is owned by the department or personally-womed by the officer. These procedures do not apply to the use of in-car audiovideo recording systems that are permanently mounted in a vehicle.
- B. All digital recordings that are captured during the scope of an officer's duties are property of the Fort Worth Police Department and or subject to police in regarding a viewing, release, extention and destruction. Digital recording shall not be converted for personal use. Accessing, copying, editing or releasing recordings or depictions of recordings without proper approach is strictly prohibited and subject to disciplatury actions.
- C. The use of a digital recording system by any officer is voluntary; however, if an officer elects to accept a digital recording system then the officer is required to use the system as outlined in this order. Officer sutilizing a digital recording system shall use sound is dement and adhere to the following probabilitions:
  - Officers shall not intentionally create digital recordings of other employees in areas where a reasonable expectation
    of privacy exists such as locker rooms, restrooms, etc.
- 2. Officers shall not knowingly record undercover officers or confidential informants.
- Officers shall not use a departmentally-owned officer-worn digital recording device to record any type of personal activities.
- Officer shall not allow citizens to review captured recordings without permission from the officer's immediate supervisor.
- 5. Any uploading or converting recordings for use on any type of social media is strictly prohibited.
- 6. Officers shall not intentionally capture video recordings of citizens while in patient care areas of a private hospital such as Hamis, Bastor, or Cooks, etc. if the office is asked notor record, misses it as situation where the recording is instrumental in a criminal investigation i.e., dying doc larations, Horizontal-Gaze-Nystagmus (HGN) on injured drivers, etc.
- 7. Only the authorized digital recording brands approved by the Chief of Police shall be utilized.
- D. Officers deploying a departmentally-owned officer-worn digital recording device shall attend department approved training on the device, review the shaded operating procedures governing use of the device and demonstrate a working knowledge of the device prior to employing the device in field operations.
- Officers deploying a personal device shall demonstrate proficiency in the use of the device and retrieval of the recordings.
- Supervisors of officers deploying a departmentally-owned officer-worn digital recording device shall attend training regarding the device to be worn as well as the procedures for storing and retention of recordings.
- E. Officers shall inspect the digital recording device prior to each shift to confirm proper operation, including sufficient batter Vife. Any problem with the recording device shall be reported to the officer's supervisor immediately and the supervisor will contact Training to secure a replacement or repair.
- E. Officers deploying a digital recording device should ensure the device is activated during potential enforcement activities and that the device continues to record until the incident is completed, the officer has left the scene, or the clizen contact is complete.
