### 2014 Harold Rogers Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) National Meeting

The 10<sup>th</sup> Annual Harold Rogers Prescription Drug Monitoring Program National Meeting will be held in Washington, D.C. from September 22 - 24 at the Marriott Metro Center, 775 12<sup>th</sup> Street, NW, Washington, DC 20005. Among the invited speakers are Michael Botticelli (Acting Director, Office of National Drug Control Policy) and Congressman Harold Rogers. This year's meeting contains several important topics for State PDMP Administrators and other stakeholders: new PDMP initiatives, Best Practices employed by PDMPs, round table discussion on prescription drug diversion and abuse, Prescription Monitoring Information Exchange (PMIX) National Architecture enhancements, Data-Driven Multi-Disciplinary Pilot Projects, data transmission from Indian Health Services and Veterans Affairs to PDMPs, and the latest research on PDMPs and identifying at-risk patients.
