PDMP East Region Meeting The TTAC hosted a meeting for the East Region PDMPs (CT, DE, DC, ME, MD, MA, NH, NJ, NY, PA, RI, VT) in Manchester, NH on October 8-9, 2013. The Region meetings provide a great opportunity for PDMP Administrators to meet and strategize on regional topics, as well as obtain information on what is happening with PDMPs both nationally and locally. The East Region meeting included presentations from Connecticut and Delaware on interstate data sharing, Maryland's effort to integrate a PDMP with health information exchanges, Massachusetts research on unsolicited reporting, and New York's I STOP program and enhancements to their PDMP. Also, an informal question and answer session was conducted with members from the New Hampshire PDMP Advisory Council about their challenges and opportunities as they work towards implementation of the NH monitoring program.
